All degrees, certificates, vocational and technical programs, will be considered, but a preference will be given to agriculture related degrees.

- 1. The Butte SWCD Board of supervisors will be the sole judge of determining the recipients.
- 2. The money will be paid after the recipient provides the district with proof of enrollment to the institution they are planning on attending.
- 3. The Butte SWCD reserves the right to NOT award or to alter any number of the said scholarships on funds availability and status of the application pool.

- A recent photograph (for publicity purposes)
- 3 to 5 Paragraph conservation essay
- one letter of support
- an official high school transcript, verification of their grade point average and class
